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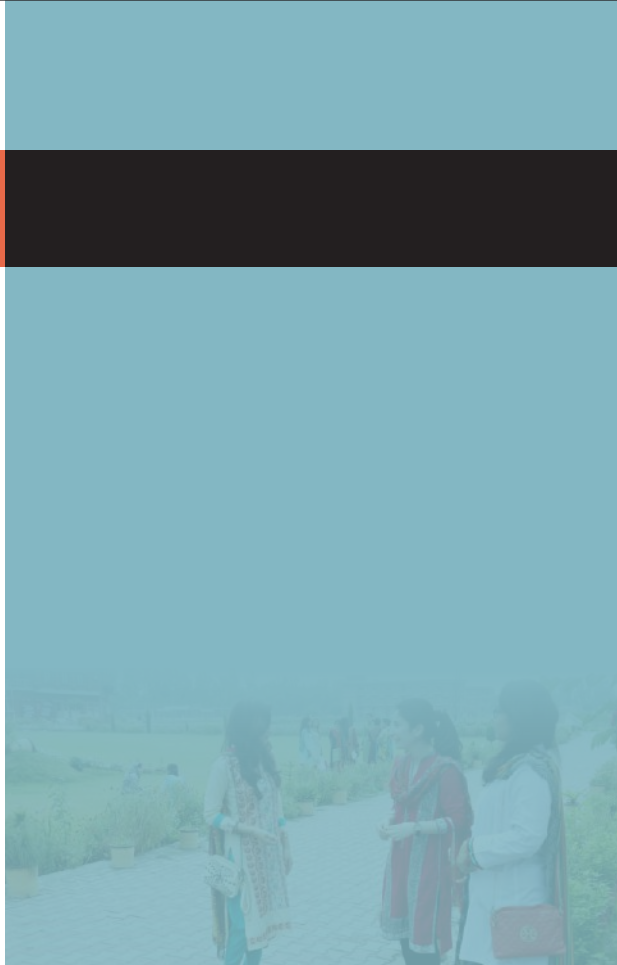


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Vision

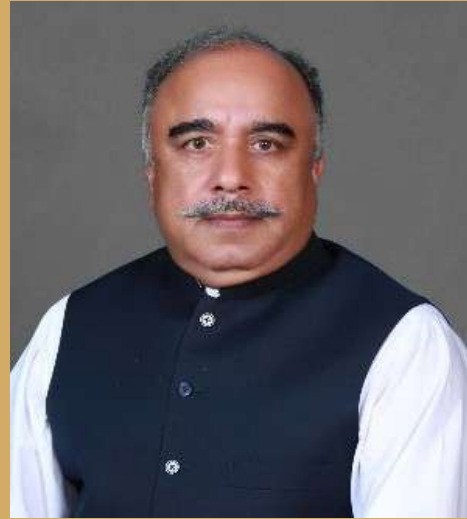

Vice Chancellor Message

At the Apex of my fifth eventful year in this institute being the Vice Chancellor of SBBWUP, I feel fortunate to write a message for the Annual Report 2018-19. I have been sincerely trying to strive for improvement and to make SBBWU, one of the leading universities at National and International levels, both.



As, every year has bounds and loads of working; this year also brought achievements with it.

A total of 02 meetings of the Senate (5th – 6th) were held on 11th July 2018 & 25th February 2019 for the approval of Budget and other important decisions, 04 meetings of the Syndicate (26th – 29th) were held, a meeting of Academic Council (10th Meeting), 02 meetings of ASRB, a meeting of Board of Faculty (5th Meeting) was also held during the last year for reporting the progress and taking decision on academic, financial and administrative issues.

The amount of Rs. 188.538 m has been sanctioned by Provincial Government for the project titled “Support to SBBWUP” including one Academic Block 28200 sft and an Auditorium 26860 sft at the University. 25% work of the Academic Block 28200 sft has been completed. 95% of work has been completed of the project titled “Grant-in- Aid” sanctioned by Provincial Government amounting to Rs. 67.856 m including a Women Development Center, Medical Center and three buses.

The university always encourages faculty and students exchange program abroad. This year, five faculty members along with the focal person from SBBWU visited University of Nebraska, Omaha, USA for 3 weeks under the academic linkage established between the two universities in the area of pedagogy, research and community engagement and 30 students from different academic departments from SBBWU visited China to learn Chinese Languages for 06 months via outbound program from Higher Education Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.



The faculty members of the university have won 06 research projects and 58 research papers of the faculty members have been published in national and international journals during 2018-19. A Book titled "Issues in European Integration and Economic Inequalities" has been published by one of the faculty member Dr. Khadija Shams, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics in HEC recognized printing agency "Lit Verlag". The university has successfully held 02 national and 01 International conferences during 2018-19. SBBWU has signed 05 MoUs with national organizations for collaboration in academic, research and student- exchange activities.

The University is conferring Annual Best University Teacher Award and Best Department Award since 2015. This year SBBWU's Best University Teacher Award of SBBWU's was conferred for the year 2018 comprising of certificate & cash prize of Rs. 25,000/-. The award of Best University Teacher Award was received by Dr. Khadija Aziz, Assistant Professor, Department of Islamiyat for the year 2018. The SBBWU's Best Department Award was conferred for the year 2017-18 to Dr. Rozina Khattak, Assistant Professor, Department of Chemistry comprising of certificate & cash prize of Rs. 25,000/-.

The provision of quality education is a vital function of every academic institution. During last year the Quality Enhancement Cell of SBBWU has conducted Self Institutional Performance Evaluation and Self M.Phil./Ph.D. Review Evaluation. HEC has granted no objection to start M.Phil. Chemistry program at Department of Chemistry.

Sports and co-curricular activities are a vital part of the campus life in SBBWU. This year SBBWU organized HEC all Pakistan Intervarsity 42nd Badminton Women Championship (2018-19) at Pakistan Sports Board Coaching Center, Qayyum Stadium Peshawar and 9th Inter Colleges Sports Tournament. SBBWU organized the first ever 03 days Olympiad in collaboration with L-Mintri Elements (Event Planner) in which student's teams (females) from different colleges/universities across KP along with affiliated colleges were invited for participation and for promotion of sports among students.

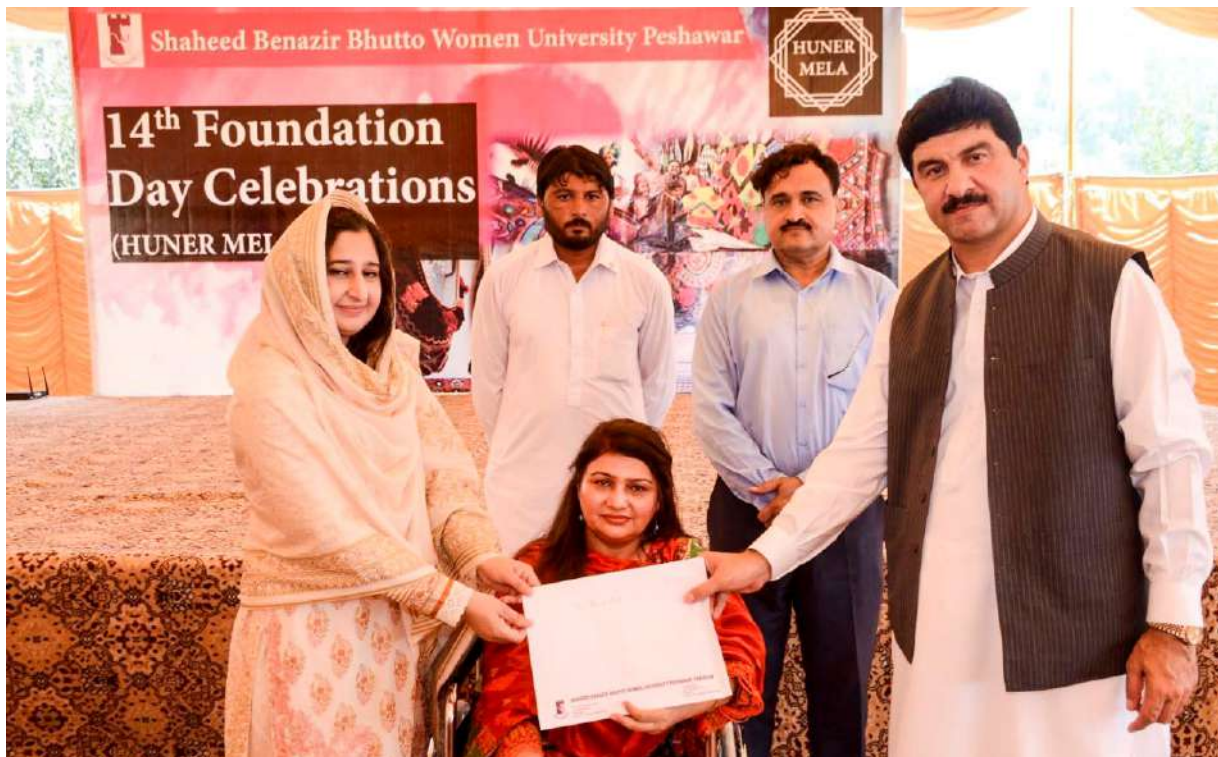

Introduction

The socio-cultural, economic and political opportunities that are created for the tribal people.

Debate and discussion on the security, political, economic advantages that would be derived from the merger for Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in particular and for Pakistan and the region in general.

Deliberation upon the constraints and challenges which may hamper the mainstreaming of tribal districts in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa smoothly. At the same time, the conference aimed at formulating recommendations/suggestions for overcoming these challenges.

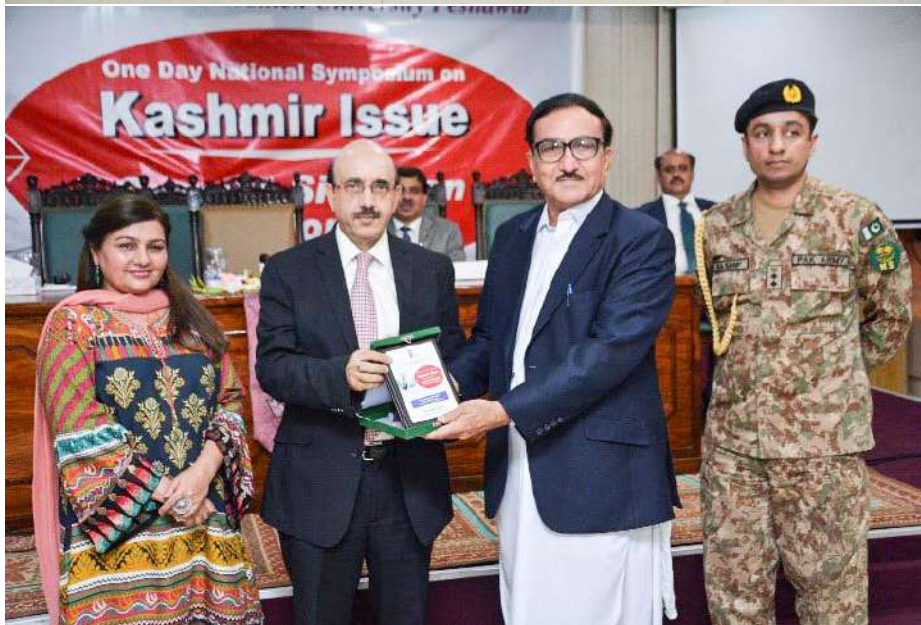

Board of Studies

Constitution of Board of Faculties as per Statutes

- 1) There should be a Board of Studies for each subject or a group of subjects, as may be prescribed by Regulations.
- 2) Each Board of Studies shall consist of:
 - i. The Chairperson or principal or director of the teaching department/ Institute or a constituent college or centre as the case may be, who shall also act as convener of the Board of Studies.

Provided that where the Dean performs the duty of Chairperson of the department, the HoD concerned shall also be the member of the Board of Studies.

- ii. Professors and associate professors in the teaching departments:
 Provided that if the total number of university teachers under sub-clause (i) and (ii) comes to less than five, then the Dean of the faculty concerned shall nominate Assistant Professor of Lecturers of the department preferably Ph.D or MS/M.Phil to complete the number.

iii. Three teachers from outside the University to be nominated by the Dean of Faculty concerned from the panel presented by the chairperson concerned: and

- iv. The board of studies may co-opt expert(s) on need.

Provided that in case of professional subjects such as Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Commerce, Dentistry, Education, Engineering, Law, Medicine, Home Economics or any other subjects prescribed as such by Statutes, which are taught in the constituent colleges, the composition of Board of Studies remain the same.

Provided further that in the case of subjects which are taught in the affiliated colleges only, and not in the University, the Board of Studies shall consist of:

- a) The Dean of the faculty concerned, who shall act as Convener of the Board of the Board of studies.
- b) The Principal(s) of the college(s) concerned who shall act as Secretary of the Board of Studies.
- c) Three teachers of the colleges, to be nominated by Vice Chancellor, and
- d) Two experts to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor.
- 3) The term of office of members of the Board of studies other than ex-officio members shall be three years.
- 4) The quorum for meetings of the Board of studies shall be one-half of the total number of members excluding non-existent categories, a fraction being counted as one.
- 5) The function of the Board of Studies shall be:
 - a) To advise the Authorities on all academic matters connected with instruction, research and examination in the subject or subjects concerned.
 - b) To propose curricula and syllabi for all degrees, diplomas and certificates courses in the subject or subjects concerned:
 - c) To suggest a panel of names of paper-setters and Examiners and Subject Experts in the subjects concerned: and
 - d) To perform such other functions as may be prescribed by Regulations.

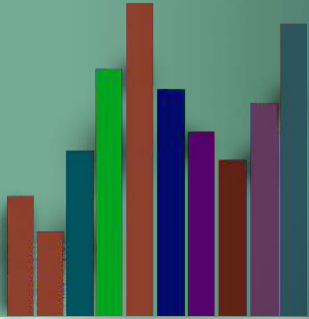

Actuals for the financial year 2018-2019, Revised Budget & Actuals for the financial year 2019-2020 and Budget Estimates for the financial year 2020-2021 were prepared on the basis of actual of financial year 2019-2020.

1. ACTUALS FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2018-2019

The Senate in its 6th meeting held on 25.02.2019 approved the Budget Estimates for Financial Year 2018-2019 with an opening balance of Rs.67.777 million, which includes Rs.30.854 million for construction of Women Development Center and Rs.5.502 million for construction of Medical Center.

Against the Revised Budget 2018-2019, the Actual Expenditure of Rs.558.988 million during the year comprised of Rs.289.567 million as salaries of staff/faculty/officers, Rs.20.764 million as TTS Salary and Rs.248.657 million on account of non-salary expenditures. However, using strict financial discipline and control on unnecessary expenditure, the year 2018-2019 was closed with a balance of Rs.41.271 million.

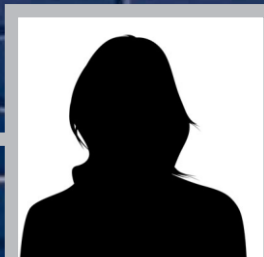
