“FLOOD RELIEF CAMP” AT SBBWUP

The catastrophic flooding all across the country left many in great destitution and homelessness. We as a country should come together in trying times and support our afflicted brothers and sisters. The Shaheed Benazir Bhutto Women University in Peshawar's faculty and students recognized their need to serve their community for this reason and made a sincere effort.

On the directives of the worthy Vice Chancellor, Professor Doctor Safia Ahmad, the establishment and faculty of the university held a Flood Relief Camp to collect, assemble and distribute basic survival necessities to the affected people. The camp started on August 27, 2022, right after the outbreak of the flood in different cities of the country. This camp was driven with the help of over 100 volunteers among students, teaching staff, working class, and other faculty of the institute. Ms. Sadia Nazeer (Assistant Professor in English), Ms. Farhat Amin (Associate Professor in Bioinformatics), and Ghulam Tehmas (Deputy Director of Administration) were nominated as the focal persons of this drive by the Vice-Chancellor. Medical Center at SBBWUP was the specified place for this task.

The camp worked in three stages;

Collection and Assembling.

Need Assessment Survey.

Distribution.

In the first stage, all the students and faculty of the university donated in cash, clothes, dry food items, hygiene packages, and medications. These donations were collected at The Medical Center on the campus of SBBWU. The volunteers helped in assembling the donated items in per family complete package, including clothes (male, female, and kids), dry food staples (packet food, milk, dry food, and snacks), medications (painkillers and anti-allergic), hygiene products (soaps, shampoo, tissues, female sanitary pads, washing powder) and clean water bottles.

In the second stage, a group of student volunteers, teachers, and workers from class four went to survey the affected areas of Charsadda and Nowshera and collected needed data. This survey was conducted on August 30, 2022. This survey helped us in pointing out the needs of the flood-affected people. The group visited schools (where flood-affected people temporarily resided) and houses of people in the flooded areas.

On September 1, 2022, in the third stage, another group of volunteers, teachers, and the working class visited the survey site and distributed the packages as per the recorded need data.

Apart from that, the Flood Relief Camp was provided with the opportunity to assemble over 350 family packages, which were handed over to the Alkhidmat Foundation on September 23, 2022, to be disturbed among the far-flung flood-affected areas, such as Taang and Swat, where it was difficult to reach for the female staff and students of the campus.

The Flood Relief Camp operated in good faith and with a sincere desire to assist the people of our country. Faculty and students were eager to contribute to this broader purpose.



GIRLS COMMUNITY CLUB, SBBWU CELEBRATES THE BIRTH OF THE NATION

On August 18, 2022, Girls Community Club, had the distinction of generously celebrating the momentous day of Pakistan's Independence, in a way, the club is meant to be known for.
