

### **Empowering Women Entrepreneurs: Unlocking Pakistan's Potential in the Global Start-up Market**

A session was recently held at Shaheed Benazir Bhutto Women University Peshawar, aimed at empowering the talented women who represent 51% of Pakistan's population. The session focused on the vast potential of the global start-up market, which is estimated at a whopping \$3 trillion. So far, Pakistan has only tapped into \$1 billion of this market, meaning there is a vast untapped potential for enterprising women in the country.

Moreover, the session highlighted the importance of capitalizing on Pakistan's demographic dividend, where the median age of the 220 million population is just 22. With 70% of the population below the age of 35, and 109 million mobile subscribers, including 40 million smartphone users and 35 million social media subscribers, there is a huge opportunity to scale up the start-up ecosystem of Pakistan.

To help budding entrepreneurs, the government of Pakistan has earmarked Rs 100 billion under the Kamyab Jawan/PM Youth Loan scheme for small businesses, making it the right time to jump into the market. The session also highlighted that the State Bank of Pakistan, in collaboration with banks, has developed women-centric financing products that

can be availed to become part of the 5 million SME club of Pakistan that contributes 25% in exports, 78% in industrial labor, 30% in GDP, and 40% in FBR collection.

The session inspired and motivated the female students to explore the vast opportunities available in the start-up market and contribute to the economic growth of Pakistan.
