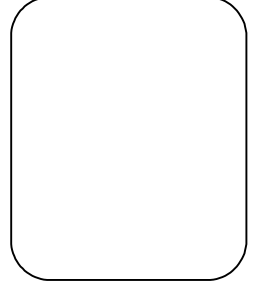

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SELECTION OF THE BEST UNIVERSITY TEACHER AWARD**

1. The award consist of cash prize Rs. 25000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with a certificate.
2. The competition for the award will be intra-university and only one award will be offered every year subject to the fulfillment of required criteria.
3. The following categories of the teachers will be eligible for the award:
  - a. Regular Full-time faculty member
  - b. Contractual Full-time faculty member
4. There should be no disciplinary proceedings or adverse remarks in the ACRs against a nominee during the last three years
5. Only those teachers can be nominated who have minimum two years consecutive service as a member of permanent faculty of the university.
6. The name of the Best University Teacher shall be recommended to the Vice Chancellor by the selection committee comprising of the Deans and HODs of the relevant departments Registrar, Director QEC, Treasurer, and Director ORIC. The most Senior Dean among the members of this committee will be the Convener and Director, QEC will be the secretary of the Selection Committee.
7. The selection committee will see that:
  - a. The eligibility criteria are being met
  - b. It should not recommend anyone amongst themselves
  - c. The name of the sitting Vice Chancellor should not be recommended
8. The selection committee of the university will recommend the top scoring teacher on the prescribed proforma in order of merit along with the required documents clearly indicating the score of the teacher evaluated as per prescribed guidelines/criteria and ensure that the nominee in not involved in plagiarism. The merit list of all other researchers evaluated along with required documents must also be placed before the Vice Chancellor.
9. Reasons for recommending the best teacher of the university (must be provided in writing on a separate page).
10. Certificate recorded on the last page of the proforma should be signed by the Members of the Selection Committee with their official stamps.
11. A teacher who has already received a best university teacher award could be reconsidered for this award after three years intervening period.
12. The maximum age limit of the award may be considered as the age of superannuation (currently 60 years).
13. Selection committee will entertain the nominations received through proper channel only.
14. Minimum qualifying score out of 100 will be 50 for the first year, 55 for the second year

and 60 from third year onward however for fine arts the minimum qualifying score will be 50 and additional 10% weight age may be given by the Selection Committee at the University keeping in view the excellence of work in their field.

15. At least 75% attendance of the teacher in the subjects taught must be ensured.
16. The final short listing will be done by a selection committee of the University which will evaluate the performance as per following mechanism/criteria:
  - a. **Qualification 5%**
    - i. MS/M.Phil or Equivalent 1%
    - ii. Ph.D 3%
    - iii. Post-Doctoral Fellowship 1%
  - b. **Teaching 50%**
    - i. Students Evaluation 15%
    - ii. Evaluation by Supervisor (chairman/HoD) 10%
    - iii. Peer Review 10%
    - iv. Workload 15%
  - c. **Research 30%**
    - i. Research Projects 3%
    - ii. Research Publications 17%
    - iii. Research Supervision 10%
  - d. **Co-Curricular Activities 15%**
    - i. Professional Recognition 5%
    - ii. Professional Development 5%
    - iii. Community Service 5%
17. The Vice Chancellor will be the approving authority for the grant of the Best Teacher Award on the recommendation of the selection committee in the light of the supporting documents.
