

SESSIONS / WORKSHOPS

TWO-DAY CIVIL DEFENCE TRAINING AT SBBWU

On 10 and 11 September 2025, the Department of Computer Science, SBBWU Peshawar, in collaboration with the Civil Defence Training School, Hayatabad, organized a two-day training titled "Civil Defence: The Frontline of Community Safety." Held as part of Defence Day celebrations, the training equipped students and faculty with essential emergency-response skills. Certified trainer Mr. Waqarullah Khan conducted sessions on types of fires, fire-safety precautions, emergency evacuation procedures, proper use of fire extinguishers, and basic first aid including CPR, with hands-on practice. Pro Vice Chancellor Dr. Farhat Amin attended the closing ceremony as chief guest, appreciated the efforts of the organizers, and emphasized the importance of civil defence awareness and student participation in co-curricular activities to promote a safer campus environment.
