Subject Areas

The scholarship will cover two-year Master's/MPhil degree at any HEC recognised university across Pakistan in one of the following subject areas only:

- Education
- Sustainable Energy
- Food Security and Agriculture
- Health Sciences
- STEM
- Climate Change

Eligibility Criteria

These scholarships are open to **female applicants only**.

In addition, applicants must:

- Be Pakistani nationals currently residing in Pakistan
- Be pursuing a two-year Masters/MPhil degree in the above listed subject areas
- Hold a confirmed admission offer from an HEC recognised university in Pakistan
